## New Business

**Principal Report:** Mr. Strickland discussed Mill Creek Elementary's meeting now a K-8 school and PCE will be getting Blended Pre-K/VPK (2 units) from Mill Creek. The teachers, paraprofessionals and furnishings will be transferred. Location will be in the Kindergarten Hallway.
